PUBLIC COMMENTS

Jenny Allen, of 41 Hickory St., recalled sending a letter to each council member several years ago about deer overpopulation. She said hunting cessation on Alcoa property and people feeding deer are drawing more deer into town.

Bonnie Hill, of 131 Spruce St., doesn't believe feeding deer is drawing them into town. She reported speaking with the Mayor of Tigua Cay about deer overpopulation and said they told her they use sharp-shooters to thin out the local deer population.

Johnny Alexander, of 64 Cedar St., said banning deer feeding won't stop them from coming into town and destroying property.
